HISTORY
Cultural heritage is the foundation of
the area. Settled by Swedish immigrants
beginning in the 1830's, the Chisago
Lakes Area is honored as the setting
for Vilhelm Moberg's novels, *The Emigrants*.
Retrace the journey of early immigrant
pioneers and visit historic sites along the
'Moberg Trail'.

LAKES AND RECREATION
Enjoy 11 recreational lakes with over 6,000 acres of water, miles of shoreline to explore and many places to fish, boat, sail, ski, kayak, canoe and swim. Chisago Lakes has long been a destination for fishermen and outdoor recreation. Run, walk, hike or bike area trails and golf an 18-hole championship golf course. Numerous City Parks are available throughout the area with sandy beaches, picnic spots and playgrounds for family fun.

PARKS AND TRAILS
INTERSTATE STATE PARK offers 298 acres of diverse landscape with hiking trails, camping and rock climbing along the scenic St. Croix River. Taylor's Falls Scenic Boat Tours showcase stunning rock formations and the unique history of the river. WILD RIVER STATE PARK has much to share in its 7,000 acres of scenic land. Choose from trails for hiking, biking, horseback riding, and nature walks. There is an outdoor amphitheater, an interpretive center and semi-modern campsites. KI CHI SAGA PARK is home to the historic Karl Oskar House, Nya Duvemåla. Overlooking South Center Lake, the 96-acre park hosts area celebrations and sporting events with a softball complex, soccer fields, playground and hiking trails. OJIKETA REGIONAL PARK originally started in 1926 as Campfire Girls campground and now is the newest and largest park in Chisago City. 70 acres of natural beauty, oak forest and marshes to explore, offering cabins and a great getaway on the shores of Green Lake. ALLEMANSRÄTT WILDERNESS PARK is both a memorial to Swedish Heritage and a dedication to future generations. The park comprises 100 acres of wooded land dotted with wetlands that surrounds 20 acre Bull Lake and the Norelius Lake Cabin. Come relax and enjoy the trails and wildlife.

life. The Threshing Show
started in 1955 when a
farmer invited the public to

fishing tournament.

entertainment and a special
area just for kids.

September • Almelund

treasure hunting.
